**The Behavioural Lead will use a team approach to provide leadership, mentorship, and support to the LTCH team in the development of a comprehensive, multidisciplinary plan of care. Positions also include supervisory duties and complaint resolution. A background in client, family, and staff counselling is essential.**

**Applicants must possess:**

- **Diploma in social Services or Social Service Worker and current College registration in good standing.**
- **At least two years' experience working with geriatric population, adult mental health experience specifically those with related to dementia, mental health, or other conditions.**
- **Proven leadership, supervisory, and counselling experience**
